COVID 19

In line with the changes to the national guidance, adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received 2 negative test results on consecutive days. Those who test positive should avoid contact with anyone in an at risk group, including if they live in the same household. It is no longer necessary for people who are identified as a close contact to isolate or take part in daily testing.

If your child does return a positive LFD test they need to isolate immediately. They no longer require a confirmatory PCR test.
